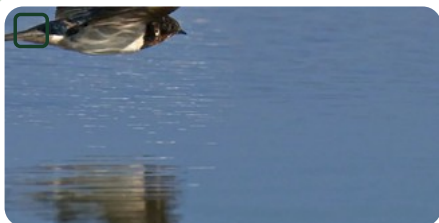

Red face and yellow wing flash



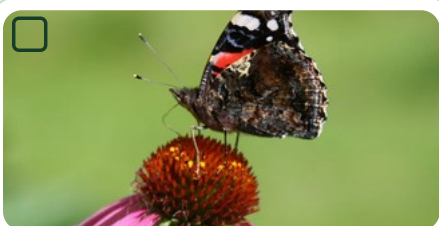
Swallow

Black wings with red bands



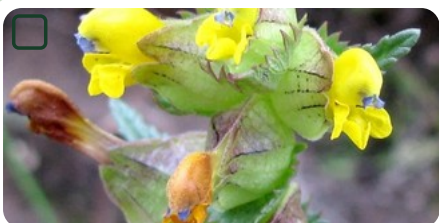
Buff-tailed Bumblebee

Large bee with a buff tail



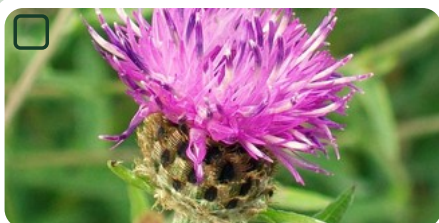
Red-tailed Bumblebee

Purple thistle-like flower



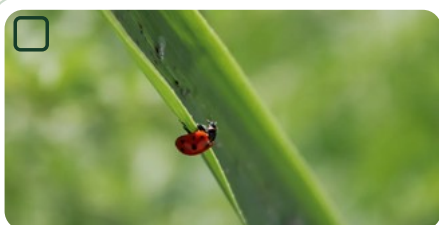
Oxeye Daisy

Large white petals, yellow centre



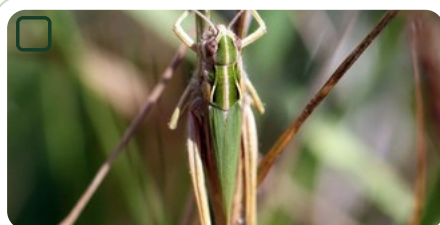
Red Clover
